For active walkers with sturdy footwear, a guided tour of the Puhahanui bush just behind the homestead can also be arranged. Allow about an hour and a half for the tour. This bush has been saved by generations of the Carlyon and Hudson families and contains some impressive specimens including huge Totara of between 600 and 900 years of age.
